CLUB DMAP POLICY:

- All deer must be weighed and have jaw bones pulled. (Members may check in their own does.) Bucks killed on main club must have rack measurements taken by management using Boone & Crockett Scoring System (Gross score Only.)
- 2. DMAP tags must be used for all antlerless deer (Does, button bucks, and bucks that have shed their antlers.)
- 3. Antiered bucks do not DMAP Tag, but MUST be logged on the check-in sheet, same as for does.

GUEST RULES:

- 1. All guests must be approved by management prior to entering onto club property.
- 2. Each guest must have a 2024 <u>notarized</u> club release form on file before they are allowed to enter onto club property. No exceptions to this policy will be made.
- Guest hunters must follow the same rules as members, including incurring fines for bucks taken below minimum size on Main Club.
- 4. Guest hunting fee is \$50 per day (\$25 per half day.)
- 5. Buck Fee: Each guest is allowed 1 antlered buck per year. Guest taking an antlered buck "anywhere" on the club will incur a \$400 buck fee, plus applicable fines if taken on the main club. Each member is responsible for paying fees and fines if their guest refuses to pay.

CLUB WORKDAYS:

- Every member must put in one workday to support the club, or contribute \$250 to the club food plot fund, before you can hunt.
- 2. 2024 Workdays are scheduled for June 8th, July 20th, and August 25th. Workday begins at 9am and ends at 1pm.

MEMBERSHIP DUES (Payment required during annual club meeting—No Refunds):

- 1. Main Club, including the 1600 block (full year:) \$750.
- 2. <u>Main Club, including the 1600 block</u> (rifle season only): \$500 (Does not include early muzzleloader season.)
- 3. Main Club, including the 1600 block (spring turkey season only): \$500.
- 4. Bow Mountain (full year): \$500.
- 5. <u>Combined Main Club and Bow Mountain</u> full year): \$1,100.

FINES (FOR MAIN CLUB BUCKS ONLY):

- \$50 per inch fine for bucks 130 to 139 taken with rifle, muzzleloader or crossbow by members, children or guests.
 Fine for any buck under 130 inches will be \$1,000.
- 2. \$50 per inch fine for bucks 115 to 124 taken with bow by members, children or guests. Fine for any buck under 115 inches will be \$1,000.
- 3. \$25 fine for 1st Button buck; \$100 fine for 2nd Button buck.
- 4. Fines MUST be paid before member allowed to hunt again. Failure to pay will result in losing club membership.

J.E. Taylor Hunt Club, Inc. is organized for the enjoyment of all its members. Please bring any concerns or issues you may have to the President or Vice President. Thank you.

GENERAL RULES:

- 1. No alcohol, camping or fire allowed on property. Smoking at sign-in shed only.
- 2. DOT approved helmets required when operating or riding ATVs.
- 3. No loaded weapon in truck or ATV. No shooting across club property lines.
- 4. Each member must have a 2024 notarized club release form on file with management before entering club property. NOTE: Parents/Guardians must sign a separate release form on behalf of their minor children (under 18.)
- **5.** All members are required to sign in and place their sticker on map, and remove sticker upon departure. Must have dues card available when on club property.
- Main Club members must sign in to either the Main Club or 1600 Block. If moving, must come back and sign in to new area and move sticker.
- 7. Shooting range is for "<u>sighting-in</u>" only. Must follow NRA Gun Safety Rules.

CLUB HUNTING RULES:

- Hunters are required to follow all state and federal game/firearm laws. Any violation will result in revoked membership.
- 2. No Sunday hunting, hunting in designated "Sanctuary" areas, or participating in early or late "antlerless-only" firearm seasons.
- 3. Individuals caught sneaking deer off property will have membership revoked.
- 4. Each hunter must call Ken Stanley or Jeff Morris whenever you kill a deer.

- Does: No more than 2 does per day, 8 total per year, may be taken by members. Do not shoot fawns, button bucks, or <u>albino</u> deer.
 Guests are allowed 2 does per year.
- Bucks: No more than 1 antlered buck per day, 3 total per year, may be taken by members. Guests are allowed 1 antlered buck per year — Must pay \$400 buck fee.
- 7. Main Club: We use the Boone & Crockett Scoring System (Gross Score Only):
 - All bucks taken on the Main Club by members, children or guests with rifle, muzzleloader or crossbow must be at least 140 inches.
 - All bucks taken on the Main Club by members, children or guests with bow must be at least 125 inches.
 - "Cull" bucks on the Main Club may be taken with <u>prior</u> permission. Photo must be posted on board.
- 1600 Block & Bow Mtn: No minimum size required for any buck taken on 1600 or Bow Mtn by members, children or guests.
- Turkey: Areas for spring turkey season are on a first come basis. Must maintain 500 yards distance from other hunters. No rifles allowed. Guests are allowed 2 gobblers per year.

DEER STAND POLICY:

- 1. Main Club members are allowed 3 stand sites (2 on the main club and 1 on the 1600 block.) All selected sites must be approved in advance by Ken Stanley. (Bow Mtn members see Jeff Morris.)
- 2. Each stand site must be at least 300 yards away from next nearest stand site.

- 3. Returning members keep their stand sites from last year, unless they want to change location.
- New stand sites may be selected during club workdays.
- 5. NEW MEMBERS: To prevent safety issues with stands set up in the wrong spot, all new main club members must have their actual stand locations confirmed on the ground by management before setting up stands. All stands MUST be setup no later than Sep 30th.
- 6. Stands must be portable: tri-pods, ladders, lock-on's, climbers. No wooden stands or spikes/nails allowed in trees. Each hunter must inspect his stand for safety each time before using it, and wear a <u>safety harness & Lifeline</u> at all times when using a stand.
- 7. Hunters must be in stand 30 minutes before sunrise, and remain in stand until 10 am. Avoid traveling past other hunters if possible. Hunters must return to their stand by 2:30 pm and stay until dark. Exceptions always given for health and family emergencies. Note: If you hunt in area where travel does not impact other hunters, you may come and go at any time.
- 8. During deer season you may stalk or scout open areas from 10 am to 2 pm with management permission.
- 9. Members may hunt a satellite stand with management permission for up to 3 days in a row. (This is an area that has no approved stand site on it.)
